

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The City of Altamont will hold a public hearing on Monday, May 12, 2014, at 5:30 pm, in the Altamont City Hall, 202 N. Second, Altamont, IL to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed federal funded Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project. Persons with disabilities or non-English speaking persons who wish to attend the public hearing and need assistance should contact (Sarah Stephen, 202 N. Second, Altamont, IL 62448, 618-483-5212 no later than May 7 by 5:00 pm. Every effort will be made to make reasonable accommodations for these persons.

On or about May 12, 2014, City of Altamont intends to apply to the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for a grant from the State CDBG program. This program is funded by Title 1 of the federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. These funds are to be used for a community development project that will include the following activities: correct a storm water infiltration problem with new manholes and linings in the City of Altamont. The total amount of CDBG funds to be requested is \$41,250. The amount of CDBG funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit low-to-moderate income persons is \$25,295 or 61.32%. The City of Altamont also proposes to expend \$13,750 in non-CDBG funds on the project. These non-CDBG funds will be derived the municipal sewer fund.

Information related to this project will be available for review prior to the public hearing as of May 5, 2014 at the offices of South Central Planning and Development Commission located at 120 Delmar Avenue, Salem Illinois 62881 between the hours of between 8:00 and 4:00 M-F. Interested citizens are invited to provide comments regarding these issues either at the public hearing or by prior written statement. Written comments should be submitted to SCIRPDC (address below) no later than 05/9/14 in order to ensure placement of such comments in the official record of the public hearing proceedings. A plan to minimize displacement and provide assistance to those displaced has been prepared by the City of Altamont City Council and is also available to the public. This project will result in no displacement of any persons nor businesses.
