ORDINANCE NO. 406-05

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LIQUOR CONTROL ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City of Altamont, Illinois, is authorized to regulate the sale of alcoholic liquors within the corporate boundaries of the City of Altamont, Illinois; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Altamont, Illinois, is authorized pursuant to the Illinois Liquor Control Act to issue licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Altamont exercises its authority to issue liquor licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages within the City limits of the City of Altamont pursuant to Chapter 21 of the City of Altamont Revised Code of Ordinances, and further desires to amend said Chapter 21 of the City of Altamont Revised Code of Ordinances as provided for herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALTAMONT, EFFINGHAM COUNTY, ILLINOIS THAT :

Section 1: Section 21-2-6 of the City of Altamont Revised Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:

“(E) Class “D” Licenses. There is hereby created a Class “D” liquor license, which shall authorize the licensee to sell Alcoholic Liquor by the drink for consumption on the premises where sold, providing this classification of license may only be issued for a location defined as a Restaurant. The annual fee shall be Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00). There shall be a limit of two (2) Class “D” licenses.”

Section 2: Except as specifically modified by this Ordinance, the remaining provisions of Section 21-2-6 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall become effective upon its approval and passage as required by law.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and may be published in pamphlet form as required by law.

Section 5: In the event that a court of competent jurisdiction finds that any provision of this Ordinance is invalid, then the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6: All ordinances or resolutions conflicting with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


