ORDINANCE NO. 434-08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES
RELATING TO WATER RATES

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Revised Code of Ordinances, Section 38-4-11 of the City of Altamont Municipal Code, the City of Altamont, Illinois has established water rates for the use of the public water systems of the City of Altamont; and,

WHEREAS, after careful investigation, the City Council of the City of Altamont, Illinois, has determined that it is necessary to increase rates and charges and establish an Adequacy of Water Service Charge of the City of Altamont public water system.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALTAMONT, EFFINGHAM COUNTY, ILLINOIS THAT:

Section 1. Section 38-4-7 of the City of Altamont Municipal Code is hereby established as follows:

Adequacy of Water Service Charge

The adequacy of the water service charge shall be reviewed, not less often than annually, by Certified Public Accountants for the City in their annual audit report. Any percentage change (increase or decrease) in the local capitol costs or a change in operation and maintenance costs including replacement costs based on the latest fiscal year audit, which are passed directly to all utility bills shall be determined by the City Council.

Section 2. Section 38-4-11 (C) of the City of Altamont Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

(A) WATER RATES – LESS THAN 2” METER.

1. 1,000 gallons per month - Minimum Charge \$14.00
2. Basic user rate of Eighty Cents (.80) per one hundred (100) gallons shall be applied to all users for water consumption in excess of one thousand (1,000) gallons per month.

(B) WATER RATES –2” METER OR MORE.

1. 1,000 gallons per month - Minimum Charge \$150.00
2. Basic user rate of Eighty Cents (.80) per one hundred (100) gallons shall be applied to all users for water consumption in excess of one thousand (1,000) gallons per month.

(C) BULK SALES.

Per 100 gallons \$ 1.50

(D) **CUSTOMER SERVICE CHARGE.**

The water rates and charges for customers located outside the corporate boundaries of the City of Altamont shall be the same as the water rates set forth in Paragraphs A, B, and C above, in addition to a \$3.00 per month customer service charge.
